

## **FASCISM**

Fascism and Nazism is a product of Darwinism and his theory of evolution and natural selection, which interpreted means that only the fittest and the superior are worthy to survive, and, although Darwin may not had said it, it means, therefore, that the sick should be allowed to die and, latterly, some Darwinites said that the sick are inferior and should be exterminated.

Fascist is a word used wrongly having become an all-purpose word used to describe anyone or anything we dislike. It is also applied indiscriminately to figures in history.

Fascists dislike liberal and left-wing beliefs. They are often described as narrow conservatives and over patriotic.

Darwin's teaching influenced Karl Marx the father of socialism and communism which are both fundamentally atheistic. Michael Foot is one of many Labour politicians who have stated, "You cannot be a socialist and a Christian. The two are incompatible."

Marx lampooned Christianity and religion saying it was the opium of the people, a drug.

Communism persecuted Christians for decades. The torture meted out to these sincere and inoffensive people was appalling.

Nietzsche rejoiced in Darwin's elimination God as the Creator. He declared, "God is dead!" Nietzsche welcomed anything that supported his atheism and yet one has to record that he had severe mental illness for most of his life.

The present day atheist, Richard Dawkins, writes that Christianity is the major hindrance to science and science is the most essential commodity and is the only way forward, the only truth.

In Switzerland scientists have spent billions of pounds on a Collider which, when it is repaired, will apparently reveal how the universe began and prove that there is no Divine Creator. There is no God

Science is determined to be God's undertaker and bury Him.

Italy was the first country to have a fascist party. This was in the 1890s. Later, Mussolini aligned himself with Hitler in World War II to save the world from left-wing politics and to destroy Jews, gypsies, homosexuals, Protestant Christians since these groups of people were not pure and did not deserve to survive but had to be wiped out. Only the pure were the fittest and worthy to survive. Jews, gypsies, homosexuals and Protestant Christians were sick and should die. Fascists do not believe in democracy but that only the elite were superior in society. Socialism, when it sought remedies by peaceful means, was condemned by fascists as materialist, unpatriotic and weak. Darwin's theory that there should only be one class namely the fit and superior.

The writers on equality within all classes of the human race, such as Joseph Gobineau, were condemned by fascists. In 1873 Wilhelm Marr wrote *The Victory of Judaism over Germanism* which increased Germany's hatred of the Jews. Houston Stewart Chamberlain, Wagner's son-in law, was one of many who believed in German racial superiority and Jewish inferiority. Wagner said that Jews were a false alien power. The composer Chopin was even more hateful to the Jews. He joined the French in their notorious racism and, later, Edouard Drumont said that France was a republic dominated by Jews and he edited an anti-Semitic daily newspaper, *La Libre Parole*.

And still the message went out that democracy was anarchy, feminine and weak.

It may be difficult to explain why anti-Semitism became so nationalistic and respectable. When the Jew, Alfred Dreyfus, was accused of spying for Germany it resulted in 12 years of political conflict in France.

But we have to go back to the great German Protestant reformer, Martin Luther, who attacked the Roman

Catholic church on some of their doctrines, which were not Biblical, but he also wrote scathing comments about the Jews stating that all they did was fart and eat peaches. Germany became the arena for hating Jews and for Darwin's immoral theory that only the fittest, that is the superior race, are worthy to survive.

Anti-Semitism was also prevalent in Tsarist Russia where the pogroms were formed which massed Jews together and so they could not choose where they lived. This was an early example of ethnic cleansing.

The stage was set for World War I as it was an opportunity to put Darwin's the survival of the fittest, the doctrine of the superior race into practice. In 1914 Europe was ready for the rise of post-war fascism. But, at the end of the war, Germany, being defeated, were in a very bad state with massive unemployment and having to pay reparation. Soldiers who had fought in the war were not honoured and felt excluded. Socialism had let Germany down because they opposed the war. Germany felt that an alternative government was essential to overthrow democracy and, if necessary, to use violence. Germany felt threatened by the recession, mass unrest, the consequences of the Russian revolution, the working class being organised into a political force, and left-wing politics.

Italy was in similar straits which explains the union of Mussolini with Hitler whose philosophy was to go to war to expand Germany's empire to establish the Third Reich that would last for a thousand years.

Anti-Semitism was the now official policy of Germany and, later, Italy adopted the same stance.

Germany objected to having to pay huge reparations for the physical damage and financial loss caused by the war and also objected to listening to endless talk about Germany's war guilt and having to agree to a far-reaching disarmament programme. What had so many Germans died for? The National Socialist German Worker's Party was formed, the Nazi party, and it promised to support the little man, putting the wealth of the country before the wealth of any individual, creating social unity, opposing the Socialism of the Left by a National Socialism of the Right and attacking the Jews and other undesirables.

The Jews in Germany owned many banks and important businesses. And, of course, they were not Germans. They were not of the Aryan race. They were not pure.

The Nazis abolished trade unions and left wing parties. They established concentration camps for communists and socialists. Everything came under Nazi control. Racism was central to Nazi thinking as was the Darwin inspired policy of eugenics.

Eugenics was the doctrine that breeding between people of high intelligence would improve the quality of the race. It was supported by Marie Stopes, the birth-control pioneer, and, in 1910, Winston Churchill proposed that 100,000 morally degenerate Britons should be forcibly sterilised and put into Labour camps to halt the decline of the British race. Thousands in the USA were forcibly sterilised.

In 1926 the American Eugenics Society began their programme of sterilising the insane, the retarded and epileptics. The Nazis applied the eugenics doctrine to the mentally disabled sterilising some 200,000 adults between 1939 and 1941.

The Spanish Civil War was between the Fascists and the Republicans. The Fascists hated the left wing government and were determined to destroy it. They recalled the glory days of the Spanish empire, they hated liberal ideas and democracy as well as Socialists and Communists and, of course, the Jews.

Oswald Moseley became the leader of the British Union of Fascists which was 40,000 strong in the 1930s. They were known as the black shirts.

The National Front was formed in Britain in 1967. It is a neo-fascist party wanting stricter control over immigration. The blacks from the Caribbean had arrived in the 1950s as essential work forces and in the 1960s and 1970s many Asian and African people came to Britain many having been expelled from newly independent nations. In 1977 the Anti-Nazi League came into being formed by left-wing Labour MPs

Darwinism, racism, Nazism and eugenics are blatantly anti-Christian and immoral. You cannot be a Christian and a Darwinite, a racist or anti-Semitic, a Nazi or an eugenicist. A Christian believes in Divine creation and the separate creation of each species, and are not racist since the Gospel is to be preached to all nations, and the Christian recognises that God chose Abraham the Hebrew and, later, the Jews to be the people by which He would show His love for all mankind. A Christian cannot believe in violence or eugenics since the Christian message is to help others, to heal the sick and show compassion to the unfortunate.

But to backtrack. What lead Japan into World War II was their belief that they were the superior race and that all Japanese are children of the sun and that Japan was headed by an Emperor who was a god. Consequently, they were the paramount and unrivalled race. Like Germany it wanted to extend its empire needing the coal, oil and cheap labour on the Chinese mainland and needing colonies to resettle the Japanese poor.

“The Jews are an alien body that create ill-feeling, disease, ever-festering sores and death. They are the cause of putrefaction and should be destroyed as quickly and thoroughly as possible,” wrote Paul de Lagarde (1827- 1891)

Hitler believed this and declared that Germany had to be Judenrein, purged of Jews. They were said to be a genetic threat, they were both powerful capitalists and subversive Bolsheviks and this lead to the holocaust in which some six million Jews died including women and children.

Would all this has happened if Darwin had not voiced his view of natural selection, that is to say the survival of the fitness which produces a superior race?

In the last twenty years or so the media has gone out of its way to discredit Christianity. We have had television programmes advocating that Jesus married Mary Magadele and that they had children and that Mary is buried in Scotland. There are programmes stating that Jesus was not Divine and did not rise from the dead because that is unscientific.

Television is full of nature programmes, such as those narrated by David Attenborough, which tenaciously reiterates that the world was not created by God and that evolution proves that the universe was not created nor were each of the species in the animal world and that humans are merely animals.
