

## JEREMY CORBYN, A DANGEROUS MAN

### BIOGRAPHY AND BELIEFS

Jeremy Bernard Corbyn, born 26 May 1949, is a British politician who is the Leader of the Labour Party and Leader of the Opposition. He has been the Member of Parliament for Islington North since 1983 and was elected Labour Leader in 2015. Ideologically, he identifies as a democratic socialist.

He is a left winger which is the product of Marxism and Communism, which is atheistic. He is also against the Jews and their faith.

In some respects he is, of course,, entitled to his views but not to use them in any way that is menacing, racist or unfair.

Born in Chippenham, Wiltshire, Corbyn attended Adams' Grammar School and later North London Polytechnic, though he did not complete his degree. Before entering politics he worked as a representative for various trade unions. His political career began when he was elected to Haringey Council in 1974 and, later, he was secretary of the Islington Constituency Labour Party. He continued in both roles until he entered the House of Commons as an MP.

Corbyn has received awards for his work as an international human rights campaigner. As an MP, he is known for his activism and severe rebelliousness, frequently voting against the Labour whip when the party was in government under centrist New Labour leaders Tony Blair and Gordon Brown. As Labour Leader, Corbyn advocates an anti-austerity platform of reversing austerity cuts to public services and welfare funding made since 2010, and proposes renationalisation of public utilities and the railways. What he does not realise that the present day austerity is due to the gross overspending of the Labour party of which he was and is a member, when under Tony Blair who brought this country's deficit to over 1.5 trillion pounds.. If public utilities and the railways are to be nationalised as Corbyn wants, who is to pay their tremendous debts?. British Rail is 33 million in the red. Corbyn will have to raise taxes to do this and the financial burden will fall on the taxpayer particularly those who are wealthy and have capital and Corbyn is against capitalism and those who are wealthy. He is known as the Politician who wants to spend, spend, spend and cast us into more serious debt. As already stated he is renowned for his severe rebelliousness..

A longstanding anti-war and anti-nuclear activist, Corbyn supports a foreign policy of military non-interventionism and a unilateral policy of nuclear disarmament. He wants our nuclear and other defences to be eliminated leaving us vulnerable to attack. He is also against NATO. Corbyn is a member of the Socialist Campaign Group, the Palestine Solidarity Campaign, which is anti Jew, Amnesty International and the Campaign for Nuclear Disarmament (CND). He was the national chair of the Stop the War Coalition from June 2011 until September 2015. It must be repeated in that he is anti Jew in that he is strongly pro Arab and advocated no bombing of Arab areas as Arabs are his friends. It is alarming that so many left wingers are anti-semitic, thus making them racist and bigots,

After Labour's defeat in the 2015 general election and the resignation of Ed Milliband, Corbyn announced his candidacy for the leadership of the Labour Party on 6 June 2015. Although he was regarded as a fringe hopeful in the leadership election, having only just secured sufficient nominations from fellow Labour MPs to be placed on the ballot, Corbyn quickly emerged as the lead candidate in opinion polls and secured the support of the majority of trade unions affiliated to

the Labour Party. He was elected Leader of the Labour Party on 12 September 2015, with a landslide vote of 59.5% in the first round of the ballot.

He supports the rights of homosexuals, lesbians and gay marriage

As we have to be fair in our writings he does have some interest of the vulnerable population at heart and this is highly commendable but even some of his own party think he is a dangerous prospect..He is not a moderate but a left winger.

## HISTORY OF THE LABOUR PARTY

Let us refresh ourselves as to what is left wing politics.

Karl Marx was the father of both socialism, communism and what is known as left wing politics. He was an atheist and said that the existence of God had no meaning of any kind and that religion was the opium of the people.

By atheism, in the context in which we are using the term, means that the God of the Bible, the Bible itself and Jesus Christ is mere fiction and not true.

With Marx was Friedrich Engels, another atheist although some say he was an agnostic.

Atheists claim to be free thinkers and yet they fight for more and more control of every aspect of our lives and therefore there is no freedom for us.

It is true that most atheists are left wing in their politics. They are the political parties that hate God as do Communists and Nazis with their National Socialism. However, it must be said that the Nazis were fascists in that they were racist and anti-Semitic hating the Jews and, therefore, the God of the Jews.

As we know from Soviet Russia, and elsewhere, Communism is atheist. This is shown in their leaders such as Lenin (1870-1924), Stalin (1878-1953) Khrushchev (1894-1971) and Gorbachev (1931- ) The Communists physically tortured, mutilated and killed Christians on a large scale as they did homosexuals and gypsies.

In the UK, one of the most notorious of atheists is Arthur Scargill who joined the Young Communist League in 1957 and the Labour Party in 1975. In 1984 and 1985, he led the revolt against Margaret Thatcher in the Miners Strike. He was both a bully and a thug.

Left wing politics say that they accept and support equality and the disadvantaged. This is the claim of both the Labour Party and socialism itself which says that they are against oppression, subservience to the ruling class and also against capitalism advocating nationalisation by which the state owns all production and industry. As we have seen from the list of atheists, the Labour Party and Communism are anti-clerical and therefore want to eradicate religions.

In simple terms, left wingers want to be supreme and not acknowledge any other power or authority.

Communism wants social ownership of industry and control all production as taught by Marx and Engels.

Marx said that the role of a capitalism society must end which will precede the take over by Communism.

It has been said that Socialism is a form of Communism or the stepping stone to it. Communism is a revolutionary socialist movement and seeks ultimate power. It is atheistic. Marx saw Socialism and Communism as a tool to control the masses and to dismiss and destroy Christianity and other religions.

Communism and Socialism denounces any higher power than them.

CAN WE SUPPORT HIM?

Many cannot support him because

1. He is left winger and that is firmly based on Marxist and Communist which is atheist and ignores some essential morals.
2. He is antisemitism, hating the Jews although he now denies it, and therefore a racist and a bigot. Jews cannot help being born Jews. Racism is the discrimination against people and treats them as inferior and unequal. A bigot is someone with strong views and is always right and dislikes others who have different views and a different way of life.
3. He is pro Arab and Arabs are responsible for a large amount of terrorism although we do not say he supports terrorism. He refers to Arabs as his friends and that no Arab area should be bombed or subject to military action, He wanted Hezbollah and Hamas to address the British Parliament and yet they are terrorist organisations wanting to destroy the Jews.. He made no overtures to the Jews to address parliament
4. He believes in cancelling austerity which his own party created.. What did he do about the wild spending by the Labour party, of which party he was a MP?

5. He wants to nationalise organisations which are seriously in debt and how can the UK afford this?
6. He wants us to reduce our defence systems and thus make us a sitting target for any predators.
7. He wants us out of NATO which is an important organisation of 28 countries concerning defence and security
8. He wants to spend spend spend which will increase our national debt.
9. He is anti-royalist and wants the UK to be a republic. He snubbed the Queen at a public event by not honouring the National Anthem.
10. He is entitled to his views on homosexuality and gay marriage but it is a difficult matter which creates homosexuals rights above the rights of others, such as hotels not wishing to have gay visitors and the hotels being fined as a consequence, such as Hazelmury and Peter Bull of Marazion in 2011.
11. While he supports the trade unions and we agree that if a group of employees are very badly treated by their employers some action must be taken. But to attack the employers to get their own way or to topple a Conservative government as did Scargill in the infamous miners strike. is abhorrent. If it were not for the employers many people would be out of work.
12. It is said that Corbyn has no personality and is not usually a highly gifted speaker being dependent on previously written notes but that is not necessarily a disadvantage.

It has also been said that when he is compassionate he is still cold.

It will be good to define democracy here. It is an organisation where everyone is treated equally

#### CORBYN'S PLANS AND PREJUDICES

Corbyn wants to put up taxes on hardworking families. He wants the UK to come out of NATO, an organisation of 28 nations devoted to peace and security; he wants to abolish our armed forces; he does not want any bombing where Arabs are, as they are HIS friends. He wants people to protest at everything solely to bring down the Conservative government as did Arthur Scargill under the guise of miners rights and an illegal strike. He wants terrorists from Hezbollah and Hamas to speak in our Parliament which Arab organisations are out to destroy the Jews and yet he claims that he and the Labour Party are not anti-semitic. His Chancellor of the Exchequer, John McDonnell, has said that there can only be prosperity in the UK with a Labour government and that all Tories must go.

At the Queens 90th birthday service in St Pauls , he did not sing the national anthem, which he has avoided before, nor did he attempt the hymns. He has said that he will try to learn the words of the national anthem. He is an atheist. although he denies this, and does not approve of royalty because he wants the UK to be a republic. His new spokesman, Matt Zarb Cousin, said that the Queen has scrounged benefits for over 60 years.

As I write this, I predict that Corbyn will be elected as Leader of the Labour party.

#### HIS CRITICS

Corbyn has been severely criticised for his disgraceful lack of respect for the Battle of Britain dead and has said he will not wear a poppy on Remembrance weekend.

At the Parliamentary tributes to the murdered Labour politician Jo Cox, Corbyn rightly said that politics should become kind. After the EU referendum, he was impolite and indeed vicious in saying how nasty the Tories were. He sacked his ministerial colleague Hilary Benn because he had no confidence in him and Benn supported the view of many in the Labour party about the very poor quality of Corbyn's leadership.

Other members of his cabinet have resigned having no confidence in him. They are

A vote of no confidence in him was upheld by 172 to 40 votes.

He caused endless trouble and division within the Labour party..

#### HIS INJUDICIOUS ATTITUDES TO THE JEWS

He has incensed the Chief Rabbi in the UK, Ephraim Mirvas, for his offensive remarks made at the launch of a Labour party probe into antisemitism when he said that Jews were not responsible for Israel's actions no more than Muslims were for those self-styled Islamic State actions. Livingstone and Naz Shah are also racist and antisemitic. George Galloway is the worst racist,

We have used the word evil to describe Corbyn so we should remind ourselves of what the word means namely morally bad, wrong, wicked, causing pain and distress, harmful, bad and rotten, blameworthy, characterised by anger, spite and malice. Evil can be moral, physical and metaphysical and all evil is essentially negative.

It is wrongly assumed that evil only refers to heinous crimes such as terrorism and rape which is its narrow meaning, but it can also refer to many other matters. Politics has been said to be a dirty game and Corbyn may not be alone in being evil. If politics were fair, politics would not be nasty.

#### CRITICISM OF CORBYN

and, as shown above, he is

indecent, shocking and offensive wanting to increase taxes. for example

evil, morally bad, causing harm and distress marked by irrationality and supporting terrorists in wanting them to address Parliament

mad and angry, unable to act in a sensible way, having faulty thinking or mental deficiency as, for example, wanting to abolish NATO and our armed forces

irresponsible, not having or showing maturity or good judgment. The Labour party want him to go but his arrogance is that he should; stay

irrational, not based on reason, good judgment and clear thinking

judgmental, judges people critically and unfairly. His uncontrolled attacks on the Tories is offensive

hateful, prejudicial, hostile and full of animosity. His hatred of Jews is racist and bigotry.

He does not hold with the definition of democracy and equal rights for everyone

These words used here are as defined by dictionaries.

## COMMUNISM MARXISM AND ATHEISM

I cannot understand why anyone at all would support him unless they are as bad as he is. Being an extreme left winger, he probably wants the UK to be Communist, atheistic and Godless. We have got to stop making excuses for him and defending him.

Communism is based on the atheism of Karl Marx. It states that there are two classes, the working class and the capitalist class. It believes that the working class and the Trade Unions are the superior class and to have capital is an injustice. Communists believe in social ownership and not ownership by capitalists. There is also anarchist communism. Communism is described as socialist as per Lenin and it should be remembered that the Nazis were a socialist party. although they were right wing.

Communism is renowned for its mass killings under Lenin, Stalin and others which are appalling crimes against humanity. Over tens of millions were murdered by the Communists in Russia and, even in our lifetime, Russian communists have murdered Jews, Christians, gypsies and gays on a very large scale. We are not suggesting that Corbyn and his crew are like this but many Labour politicians are still identified with some of their hatreds particularly with regard to Jews and Christians.

It has been said that while some Labour politicians are moderate, which we gladly acknowledge, but the Labour party is basically the party for atheists and Jew haters because Jews are religious. The basis for the Labour party is in Marxism and Communism which hates religion particularly the Christian faith and also hates Jews because they are religious. But it would be wrong to say that everyone in the Labour party is an atheist and antisemitic.

Michael Foot and other members of the Labour Party have stated that you cannot be a member of the Labour party and be a Christian!

## HIS HYPOCRISY AND DISRESPECT

Corbyn says he wants to eliminate injustice and inequality. Well, let him do that himself and set an example and not be a hypocrite. He respects Arabs but not the Jews as we have already explained,

The Jews are not equal with his Arab friends. That is inequality. He claims to have standards shown in his life tyle which is what a hypocrite is!

He does not treat the Conservatives with respect or equality but condemns them. but perhaps all political parties do this. If he wants justice then his attitude to the Jews, the monarchy and other matters needs major surgery. He viciously attacked UKIP for bigotry! He and his Chancellor, John McDonnell have said that the Tories are evil, wicked, or words to that effect, and must be defeated. Only the Labour party will benefit the UK!

Forty female MPs in his Party are greatly distressed by him. A rival, Angela Eagle, stepped down from her desire to stand for leadership because her house was vandalised by Corbyn supporters. The privacy of Labour's former Secretary to the Treasury, Seema Malhotta, had her private office broken into by Corbyn supporters. Corbyn said that there is no intimidation or abuse in the Labour party. What planet does he live on?

We do not say that he is behind this vandalism.

In July 2016, a French Catholic Priest, Jacques Hamel, was murdered while conducting morning mass in his church in a suburb of Rouen by IS soldiers. IS have now said that they will attack Jews and synagogues and Christians and churches. This has nothing to do with Corbyn or the Labour party but this party are mainly anti-Jew and anti-Christian. No one is suggesting that Corbyn and the Labour party approve of this murder or any other acts of terrorism

OWEN SMITH.

A rival for the leadership is Owen Smith. He wants equality and the scrapping the DWP and having a Ministry of Labour, banning zero hours contracts, repealing Trade Unions Act, increasing taxes on the wealthy and increasing workers rights. How can he claim equality when he wants workers to have more rights? What about employers?

EMPLOYERS RIGHTS

If I employ people then those employees have a contract of employment with terms and conditions, rates of pay etc. If there were no employers there would be no workers. Workers should be thankful that they have a job. If an employee breaches his contract of employment he must be sacked or, at the least, disciplined.

NO ABUSE IN THE LABOUR PARTY

iin York on 29 July 2016, Corbyn stated that there was no abuse in the Labour party nor would there be. There is. There most certainly is.

He has offended the Jews again for grossly offensive remarks about the Jews at an antisemitism rally. His hatred for the Jews is extreme racism and bigotry and in accordance with his atheistic views probably based on the notion that the Jews are God's chosen people.

He took part in a debate with Owen Smith, both left wingers and standing for the leadership contest. They argued and yet they stand for the same policies. This brings the Labour party into further division. Smith referred to Corbyn as useless.

In an open air debate Corbyn ranted of wanted justice in the workplace. He did not speak on justice for employers but ranted about the priority of Trade Unions. He is advocating inequality. The Trade unions give the Labour party up to 16 million pounds a year.

He is narcissist and self promoting. He is the only answer. He wants to dominate. Only he is right!

## CORBYN IS A LIAR

But he also a liar. In late August 2016, he complained that there was no seating available for his wife and himself to sit together on a train from London to Newcastle. Film of him on that very train showed that there were plenty of seats available where he could sit with his wife. He was shown up to be a liar and troublemaker to add to his increasing number of indiscretions and prejudices.

John O'Donnell has now called for Sir Richard Branson to be stripped of his knighthood because of this train incident. How utterly stupid and petty. Is madness rife in the Labour Party? It is said that many ordinary people support Corbyn on this train issue.. Are they all mad? In a BBC debate Corbyn and his rival Owen Smith clashed.

## CORBYN'S ARROGANCE

Corbyn said that Labour will come together IF he is elected leader (what arrogance )

Smith said that the party would be in opposition for a generation

Corbyn said, We must oppose the Tories

Smith said that the Labour party were backward and was at its lowest ebb since 1992.

Corbyn said that he campaigned that the UK stayed in the EU but, as Smith said, he did make this known.

Smith wants a second referendum but the country has already voted and, today, 62% support that vote.

Corbyn said that there was in the Labour party who are left wing (so is he) who are antisemitic.. He has said that he has spent his life opposing racism and Labour is a safe place for peoples of all faiths and religions.

The Labour MP. Margaret Hodge has made it clear that Corbyn is not, nor will he ever make a good leader, and Owen Smith is by far the better man..

## THE MONARCHY

In a recent debate, Corbyn was asked what he thought of the monarchy. He refused to answer but said that he was not campaigning for the monarchy. It is known what he thinks of the monarchy.

## HIS DESIRE FOR ABSOLUTE POWER

In early September 2016 , Neil Kinnock warned against Corbyn leading the Labour party. Others said that Corbyn has destroyed the Labour party in 365 days. Corbyn complains that 84% of the UK is against him. McDonnell is furious that a leak of a confidential document lists Corbyn's critics including the deputy leader Tom Watson and Corbyn wants to make a peace deal with these hostile Labour MPs. He should not have upset them in the first place.

Corbyn wants a third of the total power and his Cabinet to have another third and the public to have the last third. In other words he wants to rule and may be setting himself up as a dictator., This is not democracy.

There is a new Labour campaign group called Momentum in by which left wing activists are seizing control of party branches. An activist is some who takes action vigorously particularly in politics and are aggressive and have narrow minded tendencies, Corbyn backs this and admits to strengthening the left of the party. He wants the total grip on all things Owen Smith has said that it is Corbyn's attempt to further cement his position and use the membership as a means of driving a wedge between MPs and his leadership.

Corbyn won the leadership election and immediately afterwards there was a meeting for Labour personnel which was very acrimonious and unpleasant. Many Labour MPs do not like Corbyn and his far left position.

Obviously, there are effective and essential qualities for leadership such as exemplary communication ability, organisational skills, confidence which will encourage team members, and always being fair and respectful. A leader must have these skills and integrity and whose examples are influential showing team members how to understand their individual goals.

There is little or no value in a team leader being bossy, unapproachable or narcissist and not possessing a certain amount of humility and not being autocratic. The majority of people advocate that the leader should merely be one of the team and not a self opinionated boss and ; that a leader must have the possession of the qualities listed above. He cannot be a dictator.

A good leader will show respect to his team and always be willing to incorporate their ideas even if they may seriously conflict with the leader.

Is Corbyn a good leader?

Does he tell people what to do and say? Consider Clive Lewis!

Is he always truthful? Consider the train journey!

Does he answer all questions put to him without avoidance?

Is the fact that many Labour MPs resigned because of him evidence of his poor leadership?

Does he want everything his own way and have most, if not all, of the power?

## INJUSTICE TO CLIVE LEWIS

At Conference in September 2016, the Labour shadow defence secretary Clive Lewis had his speech changed on the auto cue by Corbyn who forced him to ditch his pledge to change Labour policy on Trident and Lewis was reprimanded and not to change or challenge Labour policy. When subsequently Corbyn was asked about this he refused to answer but said that he and Lewis had a hug.

## CORBYN A CHANGED MAN?

However, Corbyn's own speech at the Labour Conference made some excellent comments about social justice and indicated that he had changed his mind about the Jews saying that he now denounced antisemitism and racism but made some comments which were injudicious such as the Labour party is the only compassionate party and that he would lead it. He referred to the recent 150.000 new members and spoke of the shock of leaving the EU. He was ruthless at times saying

that the Labour exists for the working class. He said that we are a wealthy country and yet we have to borrow to make investments and that would mean increasing taxes. He blamed the Tories for the austerity which was the result of Blair's government and he wants to nationalise British Rail but where is the millions of pounds coming from? You cannot blame the Tories for austerity..

He claims that the Tory party concentrates on the wealthy but his party concentrates on trade unions.

He said we must respect all people and their differences including other politicians but launched into a disrespectful attack on the Tories saying we have to knock this government back since they had a shaky grip on power. He had an unkind dig at Theresa May calling the Tories the party of the privileged having a right wing edge who had made cynical cuts and their failures included not building enough houses,

His comments about art and culture were welcome

He spoke about unity in the Labour party but was he not the cause of the divisions? Look at his recent disgraceful dealings with Clive Lewis and his lies about British Rail. What about his supporters breaking into other MPs property and offices? He wants power whatever the cost and is self promoting.

The problem is where is all this money coming from and it will increase our national debt which the previous labour government increased drastically.

#### THE RED FLAG

The Conference ended with the song The Red Flag which is the Marxist and Communist anthem and is called a hymn. It condemns the rich as if it is a mortal sin.

#### ANTISEMITICISM

The vice chair person of the pro Corbyn group Momentum, Jackie Walker, has been suspended by Labour for her recent antisemitic remarks at the end of September 2016 .This is not the first time she has been suspended by the Labour previously saying that the Jews were financially responsible for the sugar and slave trade.

In Labour, Naz Shah and the awful Ken Livingstone, were also suspended from the Labour party for antisemitism.

Naz Shah is a Muslim and compared Israel to Adolf Hitler and said that all Jews should go and live in the USA.

George Galloway was thrown out of the Labour party on four charges of serious misconduct and for bringing the Labour party into disrepute in 2000. In 2003 he was encouraging Arabs to attack British troops which was an indication of his Pro Arab stance and antisemitism. In his aggressive and biased talks, he shows that he does not understand the history of the Jews, and will not accept that Israel is a legal nation. He has been married four times and his latest wife is a Palestinian Arab. He reads the Koran, but I am not aware that he has stated that he is a Muslim.

An example of antisemitism is the Holocaust in which 6 million Jews were exterminated by the Socialists of the Nazi regime.

## HATRED OF THE JEWS

People hate the Jews because

they are prudent with money and have wealth and power. That was not always the case. They are capitalists which is against left wing politics.

they claim to be God's chosen people which makes them superior and higher in rank than politicians which is why left wingers hate Jews, the Bible and religion.

the Arabs have always hated the Jews and started every war against them. The Koran recommends the beheading of all infidels that is to say non Muslims and that includes Jews

## CORBYN PAY RISE AND NARCISSIM

## DIVISIONS AND DICTATOR

He has reshuffled the Shadow Cabinet resulting in anger from some of his MPs stating that this is vengeful and cack-handed and creating more division and not unity. Others have demanded that he comes to the centre of the party which has a moderate stance but he refuses wanting his own way and showing he has no leadership qualities. He wants his party to be submissive to him .They are to be clones and he the dictator. He is an evil man.
