Shirley MacLaine is an American actress born in 1934. Not only was/is she a fine actress but an exceptional dancer. Some of her films include *Around the World in 80 days*, *The Apartment*, *Can-Can*, *Sweet Charity*, *Ocean's Eleven*, *Gambit*, *Anne of Green Gables* and *Joan of Arc*.

Born in Richmond, Virginia she had a wonderful upbringing. Her father was a professor of psychology and her parents were lovely, kind, decent people and devout Baptists,

She is now into new age spirituality. This spirituality refers to one's own spirit not to Christianity and the New Age movement believes that spirituality has no boundaries or rules. It is akin to nihilism and the Theosophy movement in many of its beliefs. In other words someone's spirituality can be very different from another. One may honourable and another's may be decadent.

MacLaine also believes in metaphysical matters that is to say the study of reality and this can also mean the abstract of subtle thinking and reasoning. The next belief is the creation of one's own happiness on a personal journey, one's personal spirituality. She believes in holistic health which means, for example, that if you go to the doctor with stomach pains, the whole person must be taken into account in the diagnosis and this includes their spirituality which, fundamentally is their way of thinking and their beliefs. Your stomach pains may be due to your rejection of spiritualist and psychic teaching, or so they say.

There is also the belief known as parapsychology which seeks to investigate the existence and causes of psychic matters such as near death experience, out of the body experience, past lives, that is to say regression, and reincarnation, extra sensory perception where the mind realises something without the use of the usual senses. If she believes in reincarnation, she may come back as a dung beetle.

This actress believes in ghosts (see article about ghosts) and the New Age movement believes in quantum physics. She also practises, or has practised, Transcendental Meditation which is said to combat stress. You can pay and buy a course and learn how to chant your mantras. It is said that there is a sacred power in words.

This is fundamentally a Buddhist doctrine. It teaches that if you know the true names of the gods then you could call them and compel them to do your bidding.

She also believes in UFOs and states that astrology is a road map that will permit us to avoid obstacles. She also speaks about Earth's Land Ley Lines which are said to lead to spiritual places but these places are not Jerusalem or Mecca but a place of your own choice.

Adultery is having sex with someone to whom you are not married. MacLaine admits that she is an adulterer. She claimed that on one day she had sex with three different men. She had an open relationship with her husband, the businessman Steve Parker, who also had adulterous relationships. Adultery is still a civil offence and immoral. It is still wrong... but today's society is not concerned, but rather supports this as normal and as a fact of life. But adultery can lead to divorce, animosity and damaged children, not to mention financial ruin and ostracisation. It can result in mental health problems and suicides. She had affairs with Danny Kaye, Robert Mitchum and Yves Montand, among others.

Open relationships (you can sleep with whoever you like) cannot be right, and yet it is practised by many in the spiritualist/psychic school and, of course, by others in many walks of life.

MacLaine's' marriage ended in divorce.

She has been in trouble with the police for driving without due care and attention and/or dangerous driving. In Court, she said in her defence, that spirits from another dimension or aliens were driving her car.
